CAMELOT LANES

AFTER SCHOOL BOWLING RULES FOR STUDENTS AND PARENTS

- 1. Elementary students are not allowed to use cell phones, iPods, headphones or any electronic devices or toys during After School Bowling. If they do so, the device will be taken, locked in a safe place and given back at the end of the day. This is so that the bowler may concentrate on the lessons and activities for the day, free from distraction. Camelot Lanes is not responsible for any lost or stolen personal items. Please leave any valuable belongings at home.
- 2. If a student bullies another, uses profanity, disrespects peers or Coaches, or cannot follow Camelot's rules, that student will be given a written warning. This behavior incident warning will be signed by both student and parent. Any student receiving three written warnings (per season) will not be allowed to return to our After School Bowling program until the next season begins. Camelot Lanes retains the right to immediately remove a child for any disturbance deemed egregious at our sole discretion.
- 3. <u>Student Absence</u>: If your child is absent or is not going to be at school at the end of the school day, please call Camelot at 330-758-6626 by noon and report that they will not be riding our bus. Parents may bring the child to Camelot Lanes unless the reason for absence is due to an illness.
- 4. <u>Busing:</u> If arrangements are not made in advance with Camelot Lanes <u>and</u> the school, your child must board our Bowling Bus.
- 5. <u>Late Payments</u>: The cost for each student is \$14.00 per week. If you have an outstanding balance with us, it must be cleared up and paid in full before the next week of bowling or they will be taken off the bus roster and will <u>not</u> be permitted to attend. No exceptions allowed. For past due balances payment must be made over the phone by credit card or in person.
- 6. <u>Late Pick Ups</u>: There is a charge for late pick ups. We understand that circumstances beyond your control may arise; for this reason, we do allow a 15 minute grace period, so long as it does not become habitual. Every 15 minutes beyond the grace period, you will be charged \$10.00.
